

## What Is The Kickin' Asphalt Bicycle Club?

We are a bicycle touring club open to cycling enthusiasts who either visit and/or live in or around Southern Beaufort County, SC. Founded in September 2006, we are now a group of over 130 members, comprised of varying rider levels from beginner to elite.. KABC organizes and promotes safe group bicycle rides and holds social activities for our members. Rides are organized by either A, B, and C level rides. We require helmets to be worn on all rides and we encourage brightly colored clothing. In 2008 we were voted the "Best Bicycle Club in the Southeastern United States" ...based on growth and community involvement.

We currently ride most Saturday mornings, starting at different locations around Hilton Head, Bluffton and Beaufort. Rides usually range between 15 and 40 miles and average 12-18 mph, depending on ride level. We often meet for lunch following our rides. We occasionally coordinate and offer week-long rides (e.g., Bike Florida, Bike Ride Across Georgia and Europe).
